As lieutenant governor of Louisiana, Mitch Landrieu helped lead the state through Hurricane Katrina and its aftermath. He also led the city and state through Hurricanes Rita, Gustav, Ike, and Isaac, the BP oil spill, and a national recession. When he was sworn in as the 61st Mayor of New Orleans in May 2010, the recovery from Hurricane Katrina had stalled, the city teetered on bankruptcy and the New Orleans Police Department was under federal investigation. Under Landrieu, New Orleans has become one of America's great comeback stories. He kick-started the recovery by fast-tracking over 100 projects and securing billions in federal funding for schools, hospitals, parks and recreation and critical infrastructure. He brought sound fiscal management, balanced budgets and ethical contracting to City Hall, leading to the city's highest-ever credit rating and over \$8 billion in private development.
