

Torrey Pines Golf Course is a 36-hole municipal public golf facility on the west coast of the US, owned by the city of San Diego, CA. It sits on the coastal cliffs overlooking the Pacific Ocean in the community of La Jolla, just south of Torrey Pines State Reserve. Opened 62 years ago in 1957, it was built on the site of Camp Callan, a U.S. Army installation during World War II. The North Course was newly renovated in 2016 by Tom Weiskopf. It is the host of the PGA Tour's Farmers Insurance Open. For many, the north course is more scenic, having more picture-perfect opportunities along the track.
