

Research Analyst

A major US trade association is seeking a Research Analyst to join its Research team, which is a key component of our Public Affairs Department. This individual will work with large, complicated databases to generate statistical publications and respond to data requests from colleagues, member companies, and state and federal government officials. They will also work closely with Public Affairs colleagues to ensure that research and data is accurately, accountably, and effectively used in external and internal communications, including lobbying, advertisements, testimony, comment letters, external meetings, etc. The Research Analyst will also conduct qualitative research, as needed.

Candidates should have a master's degree in economics, finance, risk management and insurance, business administration (with a strong quantitative emphasis), or related field with a minimum of two years relevant work experience; or a bachelor's degree in one of the above fields with five years of relevant work experience. Knowledge of financial statements and the life insurance industry is preferred, but not required.

Strong quantitative, analytical, and research skills required. Proficiency with SQL, MS-Access, and/or SAS are desired, with a minimum of two years' experience working with large databases. Excellent oral and written communication skills as well as strong interpersonal and time management skills are essential. Strong presentation skills are a plus. Must be able to work effectively in both a highly-collaborative environment with colleagues from different professional backgrounds, and independently.
