In this role, this person will undertake all aspects of lobbying Congress and the Administration on these issues on behalf of the ACLI primarily before the Senate Finance and House Ways and Means Committees. Other responsibilities include coordinate and execute lobbying activities and assist in policy development in concert with the designated internal policy team leads, communications team, member company representatives, external partners and others as needed; provide active input and thought leadership in the development of testimony, policy positions and associated lobbying documents to be used in connection with legislative and other priorities of the ACLI, as needed; and continue to establish ACLI as leader on issue areas with the Hill, Administration and internal and external stakeholders.

The ideal candidate will have a minimum of seven to ten years of experience on Capitol Hill or lobbying experience with relevant House and Senate Committees. Will have an understanding of taxation, trade and international issues. Knowledge of Treasury agency rules, practices and procedures. Skill in lobbying and government relations. Must have strong organization, communication and analytical ability and an ability to establish and maintain good working relationships. A bachelor's degree in a related field is required.
