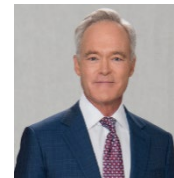
General Session with Keynote Speaker

Regulatory Update: Divided Government, a Catalyst for Governance Regulation

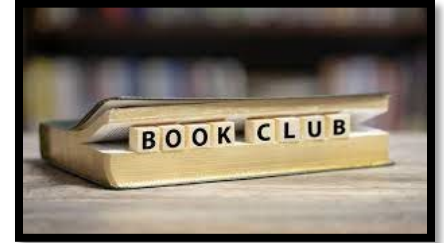

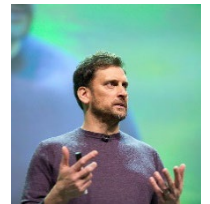
