Dear Majority Leader Scalise:

ACLI is the leading trade association driving public policy and advocacy on behalf of the life insurance industry. Helping people take care of the things that matter most is our industry's most critical mission.

Among the many important provisions of the INVEST Act, ACLI is particularly appreciative of the inclusion of H.R. 1013, the "Retirement Fairness for Charities and Educational Institutions Act of 2025" and H.R. 2441, the "Improving Disclosure for Investors Act of 2025."

Section 202 of the INVEST Act will ensure that schools, hospitals, charities, and other non-profit organizations that offer a 403(b) retirement plan have access to the same investments offered by 401(k) retirement plans. This bill will ensure fairness and level the playing field for these institutions as they compete for talent with their retirement plan offerings.

ACLI also applauds your inclusion of Section 205 of the invest Act, a significant step forward in modernizing how investor disclosures are delivered while preserving choice and reducing the environmental impact of massive amounts of discarded paper every year.
